

AMENDMENT ONE

PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT
AMONG THE
BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT, BATTLE MOUNTAIN DISTRICT OFFICE
THE NEVADA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER
AND THE
ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION
REGARDING THE TREATMENT OF HISTORIC PROPERTIES DURING MINERAL
DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATED WITH THE REONA PROJECT BY
BATTLE MOUNTAIN GOLD

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Land Management, Battle Mountain District Office (BLM), the Nevada State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (Council) on March 17, 1994 executed a Programmatic Agreement (PA) pursuant to 36 CFR 800, the implementing regulations of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C. 470 *et seq*); and

WHEREAS, the Reona Project has been purchased from the Battle Mountain Gold Company (BMGC) by Newmont Mining Corporation all references in the PA, and any amendments thereto, to "BMGC" shall be deemed to refer to Newmont Mining Corporation (Newmont) or its successors; and

WHEREAS, the Reona Project has been renamed as the Phoenix Copper Leach Project all references in the PA, and any amendments thereto, to the Reona Project shall be deemed to refer to the Phoenix Copper Leach Project; and


WHEREAS, Amendment One shall be effective on the last date of all signatories, including the Concurring party; and




