

AMENDMENT #1
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
AMONG
THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT, CARSON CITY DISTRICT
OFFICE THE NEVADA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER
AND THE CITY OF YERINGTON
REGARDING
THE YERINGTON LANDS CONVEYANCE

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was executed on July 17, 2015;
and

WHEREAS, due to market forces beyond the control of the Parties, the required treatment of historic properties and the testing of unevaluated cultural resources, Stipulation II.E.6 and III.A.6, remains to be undertaken by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City continues to complete the required monthly monitoring of historic properties and unevaluated cultural resources, Stipulation II.B and the annual reporting, Stipulation VIII; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have determined that an amendment is required since the terms of the MOA have been initiated and are still being carried out by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Signatories and Invited Signatory wish to ensure that the MOA remains effective until all of the terms of the MOA have been met; and

WHEREAS, the Signatories and Invited Signatory wish to extend the expiration date of the MOA for an additional four (4) years to ensure that the City is afforded a reasonable opportunity to satisfy the terms of the MOA; and

WHEREAS, the SHPO will send a copy of this executed amendment to the ACHP for filing; and

Now THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation X of the MOA, the Signatories agree to amend the MOA as follows:

1. Replace Stipulation X so it reads as follows:

This MOA will expire seven (7) years from the date of its execution. At such time, and prior to work continuing on the Conveyance, the Signatories shall either (a) execute a MOA pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 800.6, (b) request, take into account, and respond to the comments of the ACHP under 36 C.F.R. 800.7, or (c) negotiate and execute an amendment to this MOA in accord with Stipulation X to extend its duration.






