SUBJECT: New Funds/Budget Accounts Eligible for Interest Earnings

As the Legislature conducted business during the 2019 Session, statute revisions or new legislation created additional funds and/or budget accounts authorized to receive interest. It is the responsibility of each agency to notify the Treasurer's Office of any new fund(s) or budget account(s) entitled to be credited with interest earnings. *Please be aware that in order to receive interest, the legislation must be explicit in this matter.*

Additionally, no interest will be paid on appropriations or a balance forward of appropriations unless the legislation specifically requires payment. An appropriation is a legal authorization granted by the Nevada State Legislature to make expenditures and to incur obligations for specific purposes; however, an appropriation, as opposed to an allocation, does not represent money in a budget account. Interest earnings can only occur when actual funds are present in an account, and thereby be invested by the Treasurer's Office.

To ensure that new funded accounts are included in our general portfolio interest distribution per revised statutes or new legislation, the Treasurer's Office must receive agency notification by providing this office with a copy of the enabling legislation **prior to 7/31/2019**.
