The State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) is pleased to announce the availability of HPF funds for SHPO priorities in Federal Fiscal Year 2020.

<u>Please note</u>, applications for CLG staff, historic resources commission members, and others to travel to the National Alliance of Preservation Commissions' biennial conference (<u>FORUM</u>) in Tacoma, Washington on July 22-26, 2020 will need to use <u>Application #1</u>.

All applications must either be delivered in person by close of business or be postmarked by <a href="January 31, 2020">January 31, 2020</a>. There will be no exceptions. The SHPO review committee will only consider written material submitted by the deadline. No changes may be made to applications after the deadline. While the SHPO strives to assist all applicants, please do not assume that staff will be able to identify missing elements in an application prior to the due date. Thus, incomplete applications may score lower during review.

SHPO staff will likely complete a review of all applications submitted in February 2020. SHPO will then hold the required public meeting to gather public comment on the potential subgrants. Your attendance at this public meeting is not required nor will it affect your potential award amount. Upon the conclusion of the public meeting, the SHPO will finalize the subgrant awards.
