HRPS walking tours are a mainstay of the organization. In fact, HRPS was founded after a tour of the Lander and Humboldt Streets in 1997.

Historic Reno Preservation Society (HRPS) offers walking tours during the months of May (Historic Preservation Month), June, July (Artown), and September. The tours are open to the public and to HRPS members. Tour cost is \$10 per person, free to HRPS members.

Walks generally last from 1 ½ to 2 hours. It won't be 2 hours of walking, but it will be two hours of standing and walking. Wear comfortable walking shoes and bring a bottle of water for those hot days of summer.

No dogs please. Reservations required and space is limited.
