Dear Commission for Cultural Centers and Historic Preservation:

Please see below breakdown of needed projects with minimum amounts. This number does reflect the minimum initially indicated on the application. The Mizpah Service Bay Building was removed as the lesser priority. The following projects were included, with justification:

Desert Queen

Will complete the already multiple-phased project, adding safety features and allowing public access.

- 1. Mill lumber for use on the desert queen. \$9,472.00
- 2. Remove the old stairway and replace with new, using milled lumber to match old. \$8,915.00
- 3. Remove and replace bad flooring as needed with milled lumber to match. \$10,905.00
- 4. Replace missing metal siding with siding from Mine parks stockpile. \$10,897.00
- 5. Build new exterior doors from milled lumber. If existing doors cannot be reused. \$9,874.00
- 6. Construct handrails to install inside the building so the public can have safe access to the building. \$15,942.00
- 7. Cover windows and all other openings to prevent the birds from interring. \$9,762.00
- 8. Site clean-up \$3,800.00

Building #7 Stabilization

Stabilization needed to prevent collapse and loss of building

- 1. Mill lumber to be used on building #7 \$9,150.00
- 2. Remove the existing wood floor. \$7,780.00
- 3. Install temporary steel lifting beams, cribbing and jacks \$9,860.00
- 4. Lift and support building in place \$24,720.00
- 5. Excavate, form and pour footings per plans \$27,233.00
- 6. Install new mud sill and lower building onto new footings. \$9,340.00
- 7. Backfill interior of building with base AGG and compact. \$7,780.00
- 8. Install new 3x wood planking over base. \$8,155.00
- 9. Install any needed structural support and make any repairs due to lifting the building. \$5,684.00
- 10. Make needed repairs to the sliding doors. \$2,900.00
- 11. Excavate for a concrete apron outside of the sliding doors per plan. \$1,801.00
- 12. Backfill, form, and pour. \$10,943.00

13. Final grading and site clean-up. \$3,575.00
