On September 05, 2024, the Commission for Cultural Centers and Historic Preservation (CCCHP) finished its grant selection for the 2023/2024 grant cycle. The Commission and staff are very pleased that you have received an award. I would like to take this opportunity to point out several items of importance.

- 1. This letter confirms your CCCHP award of \$212,650.50 Your CCCHP Project Tracking number is CCCHP-23-26. Please remember to use this number on ALL correspondence including e-mails.
- 2. The CCCHP award is for rehabilitation of a historic building that is to be used as a cultural center.
- 3. Project work and/or costs funded by the CCCHP award <u>may not</u> commence until the SHPO has received notification that the sale of bonds has occurred, and a funding agreement has been signed with covenants recorded. Failure to provide this information will be reported to the Commission and could jeopardize the grant award made by the Commission. It is likely that the sale of bonds will occur in November of 2024.
- 4. Your project can begin or continue if you are using <u>non</u>—CCCHP funds, but funds from the 2023/2024 grant award are unavailable until this office has received a signed funding agreement for that award. Any work done prior to dates listed in a signed funding agreement will not be eligible for reimbursement.
