

**AMENDMENT ONE
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT,
BATTLE MOUNTAIN DISTRICT TONOPAH FIELD OFFICE,
THE NEVADA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER
AND ESMERALDA COUNTY, NEVADA
REGARDING
THE SALE OF THE GOLD POINT TOWN SITE TO ESMERALDA COUNTY,
NEVADA**

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and the Nevada State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) executed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) on February 14, 2017 pursuant to the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), 16 U.S.C. § 470f, and its implementing regulations, 36 C.F.R. Part 800; and

WHEREAS, the BLM must modify Stipulation III.C regarding the draft report of the results of implemented measures detailed in the Historic Properties Treatment Plan (HPTP); and


WHEREAS, the BLM will send a copy of this executed amendment to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) via email notification;

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation VII of the MOA, the BLM and SHPO agree to amend the MOA as follows:

1. Amend Stipulation III.C. so it reads as follows:

Within four years of the execution of the MOA, the BLM will submit a draft report of the results of implemented measures, as detailed in the HPTP, to the SHPO.
