7. Alteration, Addition and/or Repairs to a Historic Building, Site Work for Historic Commercial Building (FOR POSSIBLE ACTION):

180 N. C Street, Virginia City, Nevada; Pelosi Blacksmith Building; Circa 1860s; Contributing Structure

Scope of Work:

The owner requests approval for the spread of local gravel around the building in order to reduce mud; the installation of a patio area comprised of red brick pavers; the construction of a free standing retaining wall to be located along the rear property line of the lot in order to prevent damage to the structure from runoff; and the replacement of the existing metal roof with standing seam metal roofing panels, as leaks in the current roofing system have caused damage to the structure at an accelerated rate.

8. New Construction – House or Other Large Building FOR POSSIBLE ACTION:

580 E Mill Street, Virginia City, Nevada 89403; Project Delivery Projected March 1st, 2025; Vacant Lot

Scope of Work:

The existing windows of the structure will be replaced with Anderson 100 series Fiberex replacement windows. Siding and trim material will be replaced with LP Lap Siding, LP Shake Shingle, and LP Trim. The existing garage door will be replaced with a Clopay Coachman door and painted with Benjamin Moore's 'Hunter Green' (BM 0041 2041-10), and the accent color will be Sherman Williams 'Tricorn Black' (SW 6258).

9. Addition – House or Other Large Building FOR POSSIBLE ACTION:

130 High Street, Silver City, Nevada, 89502; Circa 2003; Non-Contributing Structure Scope of Work: Forsyth Design Loft in Reno is the residential design firm applying for the Certificate of Appropriateness as the designated Owner's Representative. The proposed addition will be single-story and located at the rear of the home facing the East and South to capture sunlight. It shall be accessed from the existing Great Room and Master Bedroom with an exterior door leading to a wood-framed landing and ADA-accessible ramp. The current entry to the house consists of several steps that have become challenging for the homeowner. The exterior wall finish and trim color shall match the existing exterior paint selection. The proposed metal roof is due to the low pitch of the roof in order to reduce the height of the addition to below the existing structures ridge line.
