

AMENDMENT ONE

PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT

Among
Bureau of Land Management, Bristlecone Field Office
And
Nevada State Historic Preservation Officer
And
Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest
Regarding
Overland Pass Habitat Improvement Project
White Pine and Elko County, Nevada

WHEREAS, the Bristlecone Field Office of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM, formerly the Egan Field Office), the Mountain City-Ruby Mountains-Jarbidge Ranger District of the Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest (HTNF, formerly the Ruby Mountains Ranger District), the Nevada Department of Wildlife (NDOW), and the Nevada State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) on February 26, 2015 executed a Programmatic Agreement (PA) pursuant to 36 CFR 800, the implementing regulations of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (54 U.S. Code § 306108); and

WHEREAS, the PA was to remain in effect for ten (10) years from the date of execution and the expiration date shall be extended for five (5) years until February 26, 2030; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation X of the PA, the BLM, HTNF, NDOW, and the SHPO agree to amend the PA as described above. This PA amendment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original, and all of which shall constitute one and the same agreement.
