Gain 2 Artifact Points

Roll Again

Fact:

A Tinaja (pronounced tin - ah - ha) is a natural stone tank that holds rainwater for long periods of time.



RESERVATION

Gain One Artifact Point

You meet a Paiute family on their way to the reservation in the south. You give a girl a carved coyote you have from your childhood.



EYES ON YOU

Move One Space

You see a petroglyph of human figures on the rocks above your camp. You feel like you are being watched so you move camp.

Fact:

Petroglyphs are images pecked into rocks.



DEER FAIL

Lose a Turn

You see a prehistoric hunting camp with arrowheads all around. You explore looking for deer but have no luck.



DEER HUNT

Gain 3 Artifact Points

You see a prehistoric hunting camp with arrowheads all around. You explore looking for deer and have a successful hunt.



BATTLE GROUND

Move One Space

You see gunshot damage on rocks from a recent battle between settlers and Paiutes. You look to see if anyone is still around. You are alone and move along.



TEA TIME

Lose a Turn

You get sick at camp. A group of Paiutes stop and check on you. They give you a tea made of local plants. You get better but lose a day of travel.



OOPS I SLIPPED!

Lose a Turn

You decide to look for petroglyphs in the hills and twist your ankle climbing on the rocks.

Fact:

Petroglyphs are images pecked into rocks.



SHEEP DRINK

Gain 3 Artifact Points

You decide to look for petroglyphs in the hills and find sheep drinking from a natural spring. You have a successful hunt.

Petroglyphs are images pecked into rocks.

Gain 2 Artifact Points

ARROW STASH

Roll Again

Roll Again

You find 10 pieces of a broken ceramic pot. You pick up the pieces to look at them but leave them where you found them.



FRIENDS?

Move One Space

Two men on a hill are watching you as you enter a canyon. You gather water from a spring and leave immediately.



RAINY DAY

Roll Again

You go into a small cave to avoid the rain. You see an old basket with corn cobs in it. You leave it alone.



NO TARGET

Gain 2 Artifact Points

Men at camp are shooting at petroglyphs. You tell them to stop and they listen.

Fact:

Petroglyphs are images pecked into rocks.



STONES

Lose a Turn

You collect black shiny rocks found under a petroglyph. They are actually stone tools left by prehistoric Native Americans.

Fact:

Petroglyphs are images pecked into rocks.



STARVING

Gain 2 Artifact Points

Your food got spoiled. You find some cactus to eat. You learned how to fix this food from a Paiute woman.



STORY TIME

Gain 2 Artifact Points

There are people, animals, and symbols all over the rocks around you. You enjoy seeing them and decide to set up camp to explore.
