WHEREAS, the State of Nevada is home to many historic sites that are listed on the National Register of Historic Places, as well as many other sites of importance at the local, state, and national level; and

WHEREAS, historic preservation is important to communities across Nevada, both urban and rural, and for Nevadans of all ages, all walks of life and all ethnic backgrounds; and
